**ERIC CRISS**

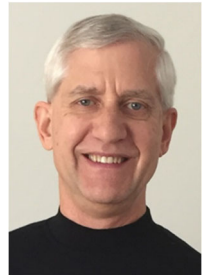

**STEVE STAUFFER**

Steve Stauffer was 10 years old when his father bought him a used trombone for \$25. Soon after he began receiving trombone lessons, which continued through his college years. During high school he played with the Warsaw Community High School concert and jazz bands under the direction of Phil Eherenman. From 1973 to 1977 he studied music education at Grace College and played 4 years with Jerry Franks' "Dimensions in Brass". He also played with the Grace College Community Band (the predecessor of today's Grace Wind Ensemble).



After travelling for a year as a trombonist with a Christian band (where he met his wife Sandra), Steve embarked on his life-long career as a software developer for HP, but he has remained active as a musician. He served as worship leader and choir director for 20 years at churches in Dayton, Ohio and Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and played trombone with the Broward County Community Orchestra in Fort Lauderdale.

He is currently active in the music program of the Warsaw Evangelical Presbyterian Church, and plays trombone with the Symphony of the Lakes, the Lake Area Community Band, the Grace Wind Ensemble, and the Wagon Wheel Playhouse.
